Dedication of The Lateran Basilica - 9th November 2025

The John Lateran Basilica

Today, instead of the usual Sunday liturgy, we are celebrating the feast of the dedication of a Church – the Lateran Basilica in Rome.

Built by the Emperor Constantine, it was solemnly dedicated on the 9th November, 324.

As the first and oldest Christian basilica, it is considered 'the mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world'. It the Pope's Cathedral as Bishop of Rome.

In celebrating this feast we express our union with our Pope, Leo, and our loyalty to him as supreme leader of the Church. The feast also invites us to reflect on the important role of church buildings in our lives as communities of faith, called to worship and pray together.

It also challenges us to recognise our personal baptismal identity as temples of the Holy Spirit, and to confirm that identity by the way we live.



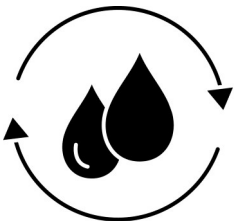
