JESUS' MESSAGE

Like the Sower in the Gospel, Jesus scatters his message in a casual way. In the case of many who hear him the word suffers the fate of the seed that is lost. The parable is about the generosity and prodigality of God. In the face of so much opposition and growing indifference from the crowds, Jesus does not lose confidence in the worthwhileness of his message. When the word finds a generous response in the human heart, there is no limit to the riches of God's love and grace that can be channelled through such persons more widely into the world.
